**Sub:** Commission Order on the application submitted online by the Higher Educational Institution (HEI) for recognition of the programmes to be offered in Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode from academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning October, 2024 (revised from July-august, 2024) and onwards-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- 1. UGC has notified the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments. Regulations 3, 4 and 5 describe the eligibility criterion for HEI, the process of application and the approval process for ODL and Online Programmes whereas Regulation 6 describes provisions of the right to appeal by the HEIs aggrieved with the order of the Commission.
- 2. The Commission invited online applications from the eligible HEIs for recognition of the programmes under ODL mode and/or Online mode from academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning October, 2024 (revised from July-august, 2024) and onwards vide Public Notice F.No.1-16/2024 (DEB-I) dated 6th May, 2024 & Public Notice F.No.22-2/2024 (DEB-II) dated 31st May, 2024.
- 3. Application received from **Jaipur National University**, **Jaipur**, **Rajasthan** for recognition of ODL/OL programmes was assessed by Virtual Interface Expert Committee (IEC)/Technical Expert Committee (TEC)/Standing Appellate Committee (SAC) duly constituted by the Chairman, UGC.
